We shall be closed on Good Friday (30th March) and Easter Monday (2nd April) Open again at 8am on the 3rd April 2017



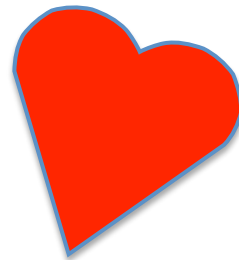
Important Note
